# **Outdoor Learning Space**

Our beautiful Bee Cave campus features more than 8 acres of Hill Country land that benefits our students in immeasurable ways.

Our students thrive in this safe, natural enclave as they run, laugh, and grow. IST is deepening its commitment to a truly modern education by establishing a variety of outdoor learning spaces. Our Garden Classroom features 2,400 square feet of raised beds, which the students actively plant, nurture, and harvest. The hands-on work of gardening connects our students with the Earth and the growing process, while the harvests of their gardens provide the raw materials for our Salsapreneurs – IST's own student-run salsa business! At IST, we know that the world is our students' classroom and that true learning cannot be confined to four walls. Our Outdoor STEM and Art Labs will merge technology, nature, and education in a meaningful way for each and every Trailblazer.

Meanwhile, our nature trails provide access to the flora and fauna of our natural world.













The Here We Grow capital campaign seeks to raise **\$4,000,000** of the estimated **\$14,000,000** needed to build our new, world-class campus for the IST community:

- A 23,000 sq. ft., purpose-built, multi-level academic building for students in our Primary Years and Middle Years Programs that will include modern classrooms and collaborative spaces, both indoors and outdoors
- A 9,000 sq. ft. Performing Arts and Athletic Center that will include a middle-school sized basketball court and fully outfitted stage, and will also serve as the school's dining hall
- Renovation of the existing 5,600 sq. ft. building that will eventually house new STEM, Design, and Art Labs
- An Outdoor Learning Center

# **WAYS TO GIVE**

### Gifts of Cash or Check

### Gifts of Securitie

A gift of stock, bonds, or mutual funds that have been held for at least one year and have appreciated offer special tax advantages. You will receive a tax deduction for the full market value of the gift but will not have to pay capital gains tax on the appreciated amount. Additionally, if you sell depreciated stock and contribute the proceeds, you will receive both a tax deduction for the charitable gift and a deduction for the capital loss.

### Pledge

Donors may wish to consider stretching pledges over a three-year period in order to maximize the total amount of support.
