Registration Procedures

Register for Term 1 now!

IST's School Year is separated into three academic terms. The terms for the 2021-22 School Year are:

Term 1: August 18 - November 19

Term 2: November 29 - March 10

Term 3: March 21 - May 27

Registration is now open for Term 1. There will be future registrations for Terms 2 and 3.

Please note that our Soccer Pre-Team and Trailblazer Soccer Team each require a full-year (Terms 1, 2, and 3) commitment. You will register for each Term separately, but by registering in Term 1, you are making a commitment to the team for the entire year.

Club Trailblazer

Activities engaging all Trailblazers!

We are pleased to offer our Club Trailblazer this year! For students from Junior Pre-K through Grade 4, Club Trailblazer is an afterschool club that engages in a different activity after school each day of the week.

Grades: Junior Pre-K through Grade 4

Terms: 1, 2, and 3
Days: M, T, W, Th, F
Time: 3:45 - 5 PM

Cost: \$275 per day per term; one-time materials fee of \$50

Note about Registration for Club Trailblazer:

When you register, make sure to specify if you are registering for specific days each week, or for all 5 days each week. (For example: If your child will attend each Monday and Friday only, versus Monday through Friday.) Your registration fee will be calculated accordingly.

Monday: Art!

Art activities will engage students as they express their skills through fun projects! On Mondays, students will learn about different types of art, famous artists, and use various techniques to embrace their inner creativity.

Tuesday: STEM

On STEM Tuesdays, Club Trailblazer students will focus on engineering and design concepts that are engaging, exploratory, and developmentally appropriate. Students will have fun with Legos, robots, and construction projects.



Wednesday: Movement

Movement Wednesdays are a welcome chance for our students to let loose after a long school day! On these days, students will complete different sporting activities and exercises including racing, Capture the Flag, yoga, and more!

Thursday: Science

Our Club Traiblazer students always love Science Thursday!
Activities on these days focus on experimentation and observation skills. Students will explore the natural sciences and physical sciences through hands-on activities, nature hikes, model building, and fun demonstrations!

Friday: Fun Friday

Fun Friday is exactly as great as it sounds! Fridays will be spent doing a variety of silly art activities, nature walks, dance parties, and just provide a chance for Trailblazers from different grades to build friendships and relax at the end of the week!

- Registration for Trailblazer Soccer requires a commitment for the entire school year, Terms 1-3.

IST is excited to be partnering with Lake Travis Elite Soccer to provide the long-anticipated return of our IST Trailblazer Soccer teams! Lake Travis Elite will be providing training and coaching to prepare our Trailblazers for the highly competitive Austin Private School Association season in the Spring.

Players will work to develop their individual skills while coming together as a team. While previous soccer experience is required for the safety of all team members, we are also looking for attendance, dedication, and hard work!

We will be offering two teams: a Junior Team (grades 4-6) and a Senior Team (grades 5-8). Players will be placed in teams at the coach's discretion, so there may be students from these grades on either team. Younger students may be eligible depending on the individual player's experience and skills. Both teams will practice together.

Please note that for APSA league games, coaches may prioritize playing time for players that are able to compete safely and competitively, given the physical size and ability of our competition.

Students will learn to design, code, and engage in collaborative problem-solving with friends and classmates. Students will love using LEGO bricks and powered by LEGO Education WeDo 2.0.

Confidence in writing and a lifelong love of literacy start here! Students in the Creative Writing Club will hone their writing skills through engaging projects, interactive literacy games, and fun writing assignments that are proven to build strong writers.

Students will write a short story, design a poster, learn about sequencing, practice sentence structure, and engage in cursive writing -- all with the support of a published author!

Whether your student struggles with writing or is on track to becoming the next bestselling author, this program builds confident writers!

Pickup Time & Procedures

Students must be picked up promptly at 5:00 PM.

While we understand that life and traffic are often unpredictable, we request that parents pick up their children promptly at 5 PM. If punctual pick-up is a recurring problem, IST reserves the right to charge an additional fee that would not exceed \$5 per minute/per child and would be billed through TADS.

Parents and/or guardians are required to check out each student daily by walking into the Lower School Building and signing out their child with the assigned after-school teacher/club advisor. Students are only allowed to leave IST premises with pre-authorized individuals, and may not leave unattended.

Children will not be released to anyone other than a parent, guardian, or person listed on the child's authorization form on file with IST. If you need to make a change to who is authorized to pick up your child, please notify the Front Desk (frontdesk@istexas.org) in writing or via email prior to pick-up time. If a staff member is unfamiliar with any person picking up a child, IST will require photo identification prior to release.

Snacks

All students should bring a healthy snack each day.

Please remember that IST is a nut-free campus.

Drop-In Care

Club Trailblazer can provide drop-in care for IST students, but is subject to availability. Please contact the Front Desk at (512) 351-3403 or email frontdesk@istexas.org if you would like to sign your child up for a drop-in attendance.

All drop-in care will follow the daily afterschool schedule and operations.

Any student not picked up by 3:45 PM on a regular school day will be placed into a club and a \$30 drop-in charge will apply. Billing for drop-in care will be processed through TADS.

Please note that parents/guardians must sign the Parent Acknowledgement Form in order for their child to participate in any IST clubs or teams.

By registering your child for an IST club or team, you expressly acknowledge that the deadline to pick up students is 5:00 PM. You also acknowledge that, if punctual pickup is a recurring issue, IST reserves the right to assess a fee for extra time of not more than \$5 per minute/per child via TADS.
